

## LYC Membership Notes

### 1. Application Type:

All new membership applications need to be proposed and seconded by a current member of Lydney Yacht Club (LYC). This can be completed after you have submitted your application. Each application for membership will be considered by the LYC Management Committee.

### 2. Membership Category:

**ADULT MEMBERSHIP** - Being a person who, at the date of election as a member of LYC, shall have attained the age of 18 years and is not in full time education.

**SPOUSE/COHABITING PARTNER** – An adult who resides fulltime at the same address as the main member.

**FAMILY MEMBERSHIP** – Being a person who at the date of election as a member of LYC shall have attained the age of 18 years together with their cohabiting partner and any child or children of the family who are under the age of 16 or are under the age of 21 if in full time education.

**CADET MEMBERSHIP** – Being a person who, at the date of election as a member of LYC, is between the age of 16 and 18 years.

**YOUNG ADULT MEMBERSHIP** – being a person who, at the date of election as a member of LYC is over the age of 18 years and under the age of 21 years, and is in full time education.

Your details will not be shared with any third party without your prior permission. If you do not want to receive emails from LYC please do not include any email addresses on this form.

#### Club Duties

All members are expected to assist with the maintenance and running of the club by attending work parties and undertaking race control and safety duties for sailing events and racing including Safety Boat Helm and Crew (according to individual abilities and skills).
